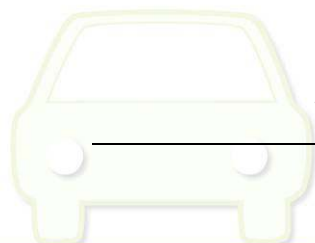

Topics	<p>The aim of the workshop is to check for possibilities for standardization on a European level of pure oils, residue fuels and biomass derivatives, like</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ CWA High content and alternative biodiesel blends for city transport fleets ▪ CWA Biogas for transportation purposes <p>CWA stands for CEN Workshop Agreement, a consensus based agreement usable in the entire market on specific solutions and widely available from the 30 member bodies of CEN, the European Committee for Standardization.</p> <p>Presentations of three different field experiences of alternative fuels in fleet application are envisaged. Apart from these practices, the workshop participants will debate on hurdles encountered, problems solved and standard-type of documents needed to promote the application of the biofuels.</p> <p>Fleet owners, logistic equipment constructors and biofuel suppliers are invited to prepare the ground for CEN standards or CWA's that may support installation permission, engine warranties and local licensing.</p>
